- 1. Be in grades 9-12 and currently attend <u>Grand Rapids Public Schools</u>
- 2. Attend an Open Enrollment event with a completed, parent/guardian-signed application. **Both are required for priority enrollment consideration**. Studio placements are made on a first-come, first-served basis, so contact us at <a href="teenprogram@wmcat.org">teenprogram@wmcat.org</a> to receive an application in advance.
- 3. WMCAT staff will notify all students to confirm their placement before the first day of class.
